


Definition

Skin cancer is a disease in which cancer cells grow in the skin. The term "skin cancer" refers to three different conditions. The two most common forms of skin cancer are Basal Cell Carcinoma and Squamous Cell Carcinoma. Together, these two are also referred to as Non-melanoma skin cancer.



Melanoma is generally the most serious form of skin cancer because it tends to spread (metastasize) throughout the body quickly

Basal Cell Carcinoma or Basal Cell Carcinoma Epithelioma



Basal cell carcinoma usually occurs in sun-exposed areas of your body, such as your face, ears or scalp.

Basal cell carcinoma may appear as:

- ✓ A pearly or waxy bump
- ✓ A flat, flesh-colored or brown scar-like lesion

Squamous Cell Carcinoma

Most often, Squamous Cell Carcinoma occurs on sunexposed areas of your body, such as your face, lips, ears and hands. Squamous cell carcinoma may appear as:

- ✓ A firm, red nodule
- A flat lesion with a scaly, crusted surface







Melanoma

Melanoma can develop anywhere on your body, in otherwise normal skin or in an existing mole that becomes cancerous. Melanoma most often appears on the trunk, head or neck of affected men. In women, this type of cancer most often develops on the lower legs. In both men and women, melanoma can occur on skin that hasn't been exposed to the sun. Melanoma can affect people of any skin tone. In people with darker skin tones, melanoma tends to occur on the palms or soles, or under the fingernails or toenails.

Melanoma signs include:

- ✓ A large brownish spot with darker speckles
- ✓ A mole that changes in color, size or feel or that bleeds
- ✓ A small lesion with an irregular border and portions that appear red, white, blue or blue-black
- ✓ Dark lesions on your palms, soles, fingertips or toes, or on mucous membranes lining your mouth, nose, vagina or anus

Black Drawing Poultice

Ingredient List

1 cup Red Clover Blossoms

12 lg. Peeled Garlic Cloves***

- 1/3 cup Dried Pwd Poke Root
- 2 Tablespoons Goldenseal Root Pwd
- 2 tablespoons Activated Charcoal
- 1 Tsp. Tea Tree Oil
- 1 Cup Bentonite Clay
- 1 Cup Slippery elm inner bark

Raw Apple Cider Vinegar**

1 oz Blood Root Tincture per 8 oz of liquid

Combining Instructions:

In a Magic Bullet first pour a 2 oz portion of the *50/50 solution, be sure the solution is on the bottom of the bullet.

Then add the amount of Herbal mix needed on top of the liquid. (Do not put the powder in first or it doesn't work well.)

The amount of Herbal Mix used will depend on the size of poultice you are making.

Start with smaller amounts.

*50/50 Solution is 50% Distilled Water and 50% Apple Cider Vinegar

Add more *50/50 solution on top of the Herbal Mix.

For each 8 oz of *50/50 solution add 1 oz of Bloodroot Extract.

Then blend, add more *50/50 solution as needed until it is like a paste.

Add 1/4 teaspoon of Tea Tree Oil to every 8 oz of liquid used.

Add 3 large Garlic Cloves to every 16 oz liquid used.

Blend until smooth, add additional liquid as needed.

*This can be stored in a glass container with a lid and refrigerated for up to one week.

Do not be alarmed by articles in national publications each spring, warning people to avoid sunbathing, saying it is cancer-forming. The sun cannot cause cancer.
